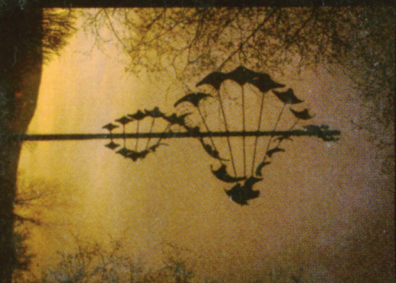


# *The Bennington*

-Seven fine art galleries with a focus on representational, wildlife art, and one of the largest collections of South-Western Native American Art and Artifacts in New England.

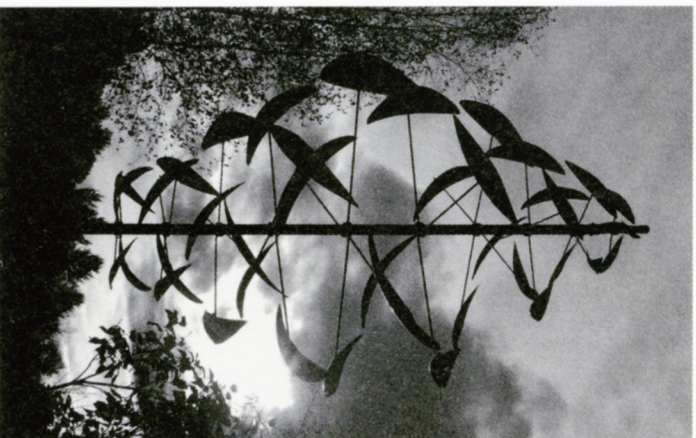
-315 seat theater that houses an exquisite Fazioli grand piano.

-Annual sales exhibitions are held each year giving artists and patrons a chance to both display and purchase fine art.

-Lyman Whitaker Wind-Sculptures are available for purchase. The sculptures created by Lyman Whitaker of Southwest Utah, are fabricated from copper, steel, and stainless steel that provide beauty and strength.

The Covered Bridge is dedicated to the preservation of covered bridges and features informational exhibits on engineering, construction, and nature as well as a documentary on the rich history of covered bridges.

Thirteen Floyd Scholz bird carvings in our permanent collection. Floyd is universally recognized as a top carver of birds in the world. He also has a studio at The Bennington where several carving workshops are held each year.
